

Start this walking trail at Heene Community Centre or Marine Gardens - 3.4 miles, 1.20 hours – follow the letters to walk the circular trail.



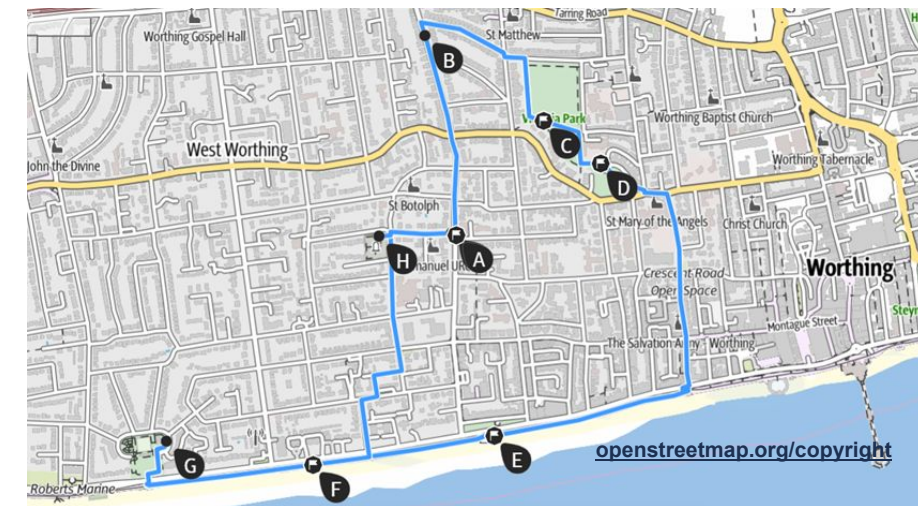
#### A. Heene Community Centre

Turning a grey space into green, Heene Community Centre, has started to transform their outdoor spaces into more pollinator friendly areas. Cafe open Monday to Friday 9.30 to 4pm; Saturdays 9am to 2pm



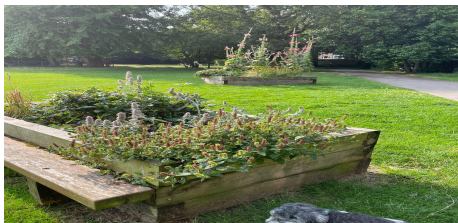
#### B. Henry House

The front garden was turned into a “meadow” a few years ago with native plants and seeds.



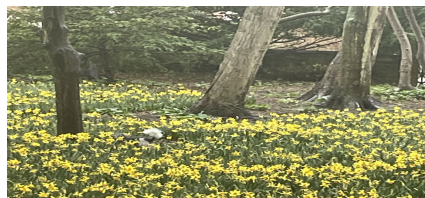
#### C. Victoria Park

Managed by the Friends of Heene Cemetery, this closed cemetery has an extensive wildflower meadow. The friends record species and work hard to support more wildlife.
