
Start this walking trail at Dukes Coffee Shop (A) or Broadwater 2.9 miles, 1 hour – follow the letters to walk the circular trail.

B. Fairoak Triangle is managed by Tarring Flood Action Group which is composed of local resident volunteers and was formed in 2016 in response to recent localised flooding and property damage in the Tarring Conservation Area.



C. Thomas A Becket Junior School is supporting our wildlife corridor by planting and caring for wildflowers on their Forest School site. Not accessible





D. Broadwater Green is managed by Worthing Borough Council
The main area of the park will be mown. There will be unmown areas to allow renaturing: around the park's perimeter edges and on top of the mound in the southeast corner





F. Cortis Wildlife Garden
This tranquil and biodiverse space is managed by a core crew of volunteers who have transformed the once sterile grass area into a variety of habitats



G. Tarring Park
