D. The Sussex Dolphin Project - the Shoreham Port Conservation Corridor (SPCC) is a unique project site, nestled in the industrialised area of Shoreham Port, and bordered by housing, making it an isolated and important first land-fall for migratory butterfly species.



E. St Aubyns Crescent Corner garden, BN41 1PJ - Eastbrook Community Gardeners are a small group who came together to improve Southwick and Fishersgate green spaces for the wellbeing of people and pollinators, focusing on sowing flowers and planting trees.
